

In FY 2019, CFPA provided the following services:

- **9,909 safe nights in shelter** for individuals and families fleeing violence or abuse
- **2,063 Orders of Protection** to keep abusers away from their victims
- **20,320 hours** of services to **979 seniors and adults living with disabilities** who were abused, neglected, or financially exploited
- **1,145 staff and volunteer visits** to nursing homes to check on the well-being of residents
- **541 children and adults** healing from the trauma of sexual abuse through therapy services
- **230 men and women** attended the 26-week Family Violence Intervention Project to learn about violence-free relationships
- **35,816 students** in Peoria, Tazewell, and Woodford Counties received **3,841 classroom presentations** on child sexual abuse prevention, bullying prevention, healthy relationships, teen dating violence prevention, human trafficking prevention, and more
- **22 victims** of labor and sex trafficking received comprehensive care and services
- **66 hours** of training provided to law enforcement, first responders, medical providers, utility workers, and more about human trafficking indicators
- **308 medical advocacies** in local emergency departments for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault

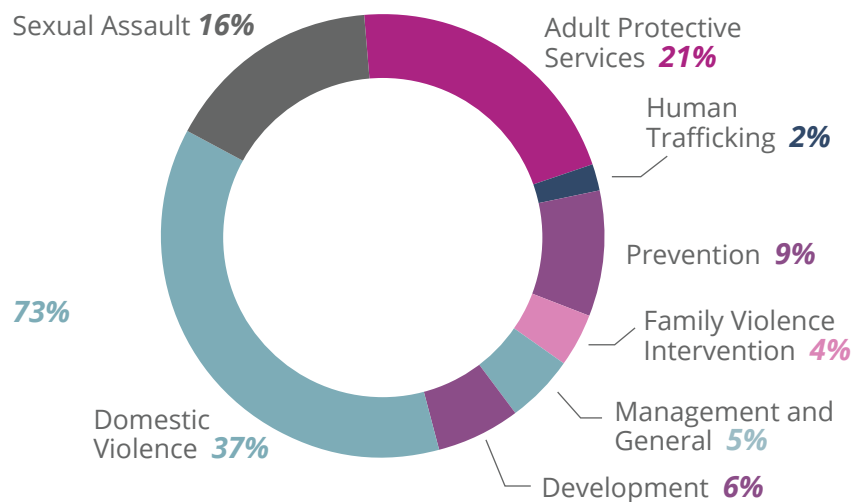
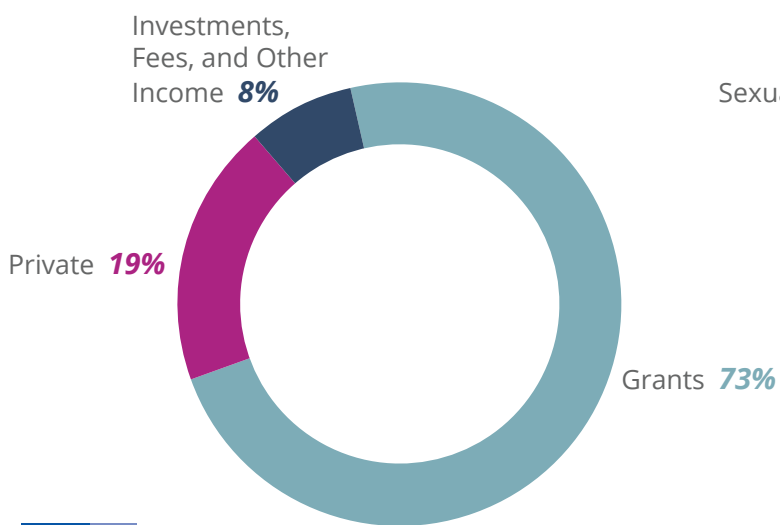
CFPA partners with school districts, the courts, probation officers, city and county officials, and other organizations to maximize our outcomes and to build a safe and peaceful community.
